Sermon Title: “*The Beautiful Sacrifice*”

Theme of Sermon: Let us offer beautiful and costly sacrifices to our Glorious Savior in the New and Final Temple of God!

Scripture Lesson: Haggai 2:2-9; Mark 12:41-44

Scripture Text: Mark 14:1-11

Questions for Family Discussion/ Thoughtful Meditation:

* **Read Mark 12:41-44 and Mark 14:1-11.** These scriptures make up another “Mark Sandwich” (intercalation). Compare the two women; compare the two offerings; compare the two locations, etc. How does this help you to better understand Mark’s purpose in the way he teaches chapter 13?

* **Children:** Contrast true affections for Jesus and false affections for mere religion in this passage.

* How does the Word of God teach us that we are God’s temple? What are the implications of this for our daily lives?
